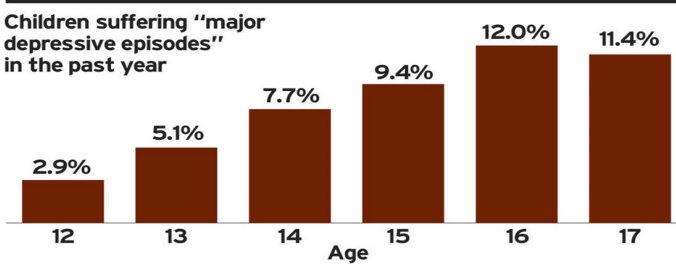
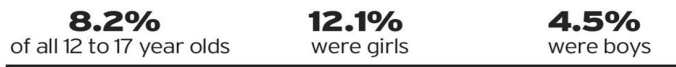

70% 70% of youth in state and local juvenile justice systems have a mental illness.¹

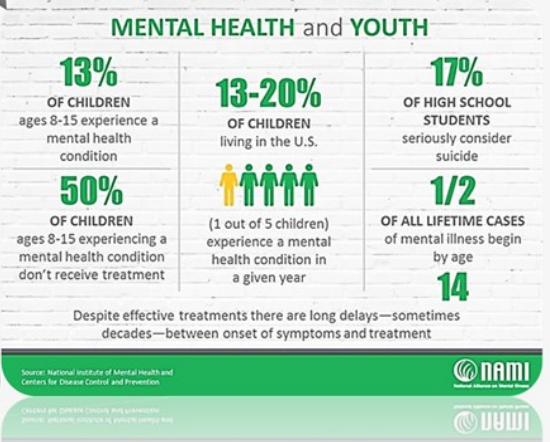


Children and treatment
